VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING TUESDAY—MARCH 10, 2020 VILLAGE HALL BOARD ROOM

<u>CALL TO ORDER:</u> Village President Hofeld called the regular meeting to order at 7 p.m. There were three members of the public and one press representative present.

A motion was made by Trustee Purcell and seconded by Trustee Roman to accept the appointment of Kim Luytgaarden and reappointment of Brandon Svec.
